

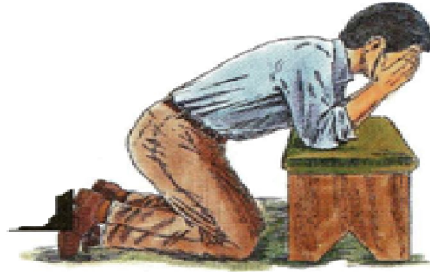

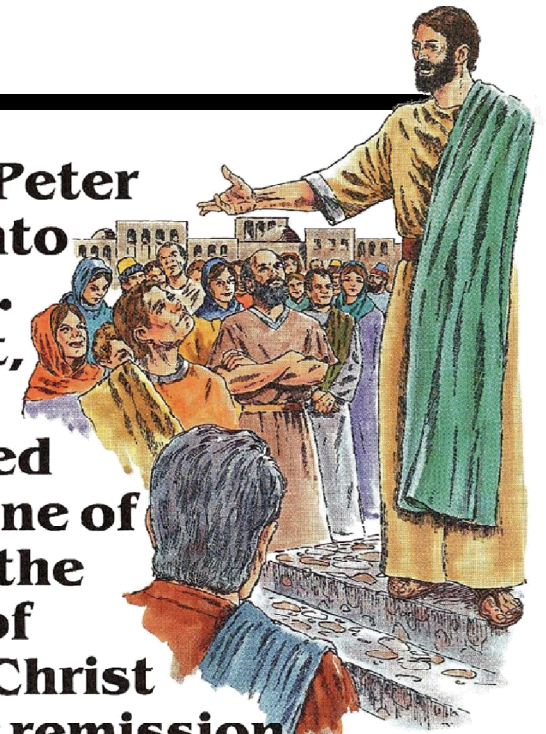

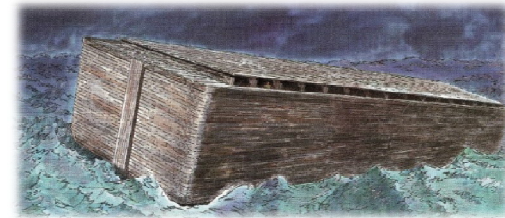


Acts 10:48

The Bible says here that baptism now saves us.

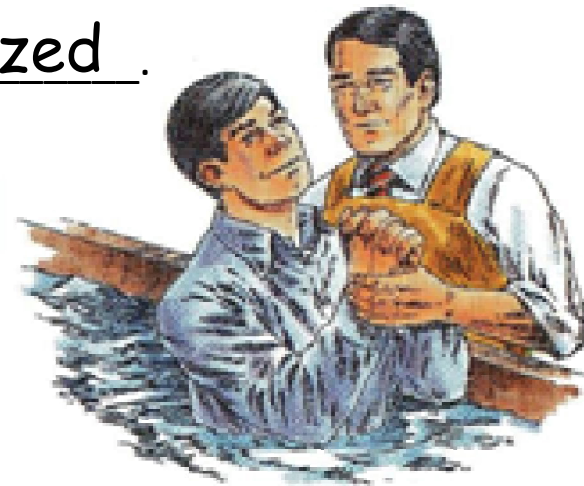


Mark 16:16

Acts 8:38-39 and Matthew 3:16

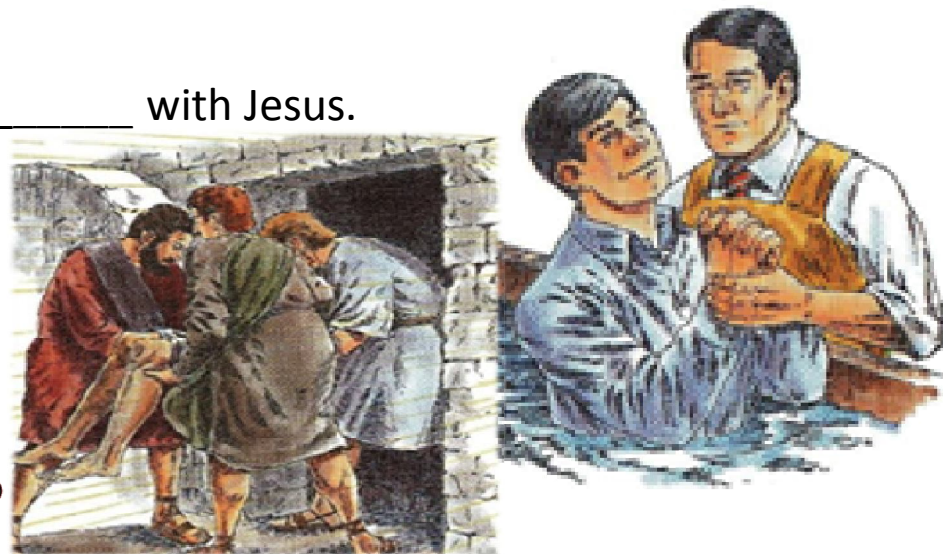
Baptism takes place *IN* a body of water.

Immerse or Sprinkle?



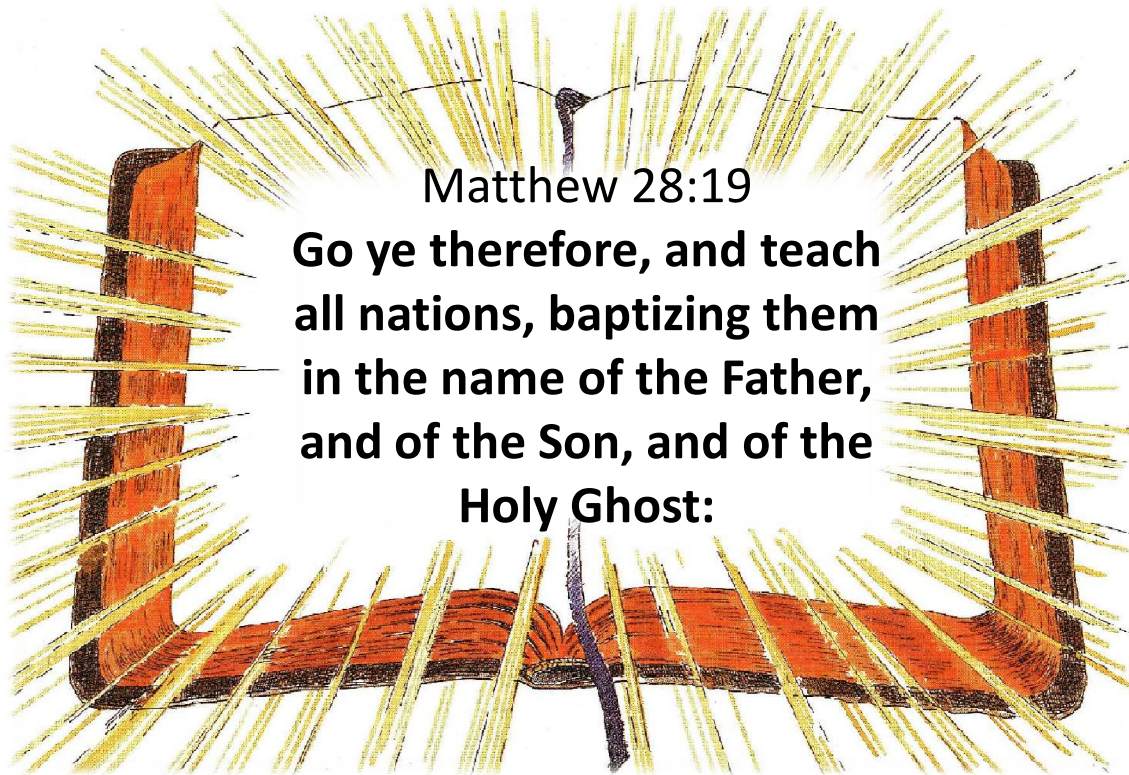
Acts 4:12

THE COVENANT NAME

“Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost.” Matthew 28:19

The name of the Father is:
 (“I am come in my Father’s Name.”) John 5:43

The name of the Son is:
 (“Thou shalt call his name JESUS.”) Matthew 1:21

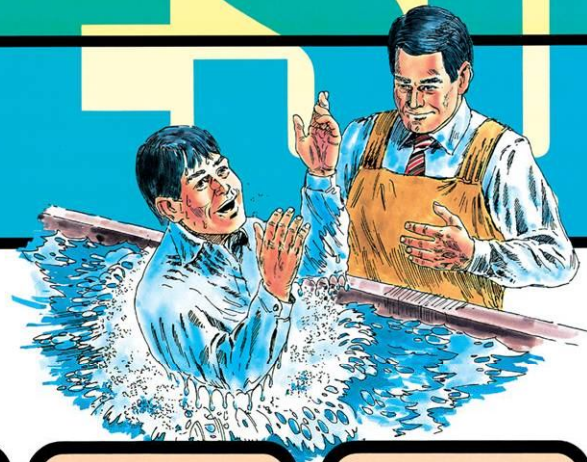
The name of the Holy Ghost is:
 (“The Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name.”) John 14:26
