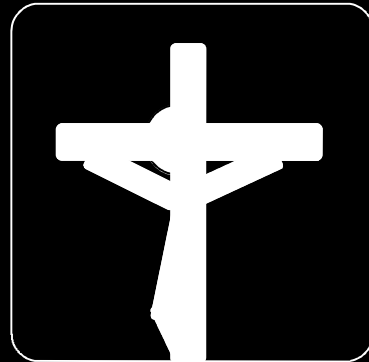

Romans 1:16

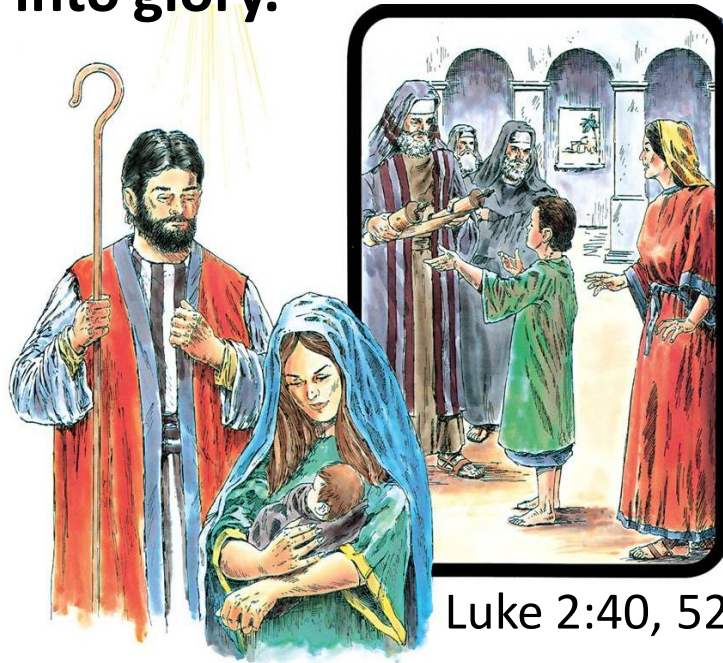
For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

Jesus was **God** in the flesh

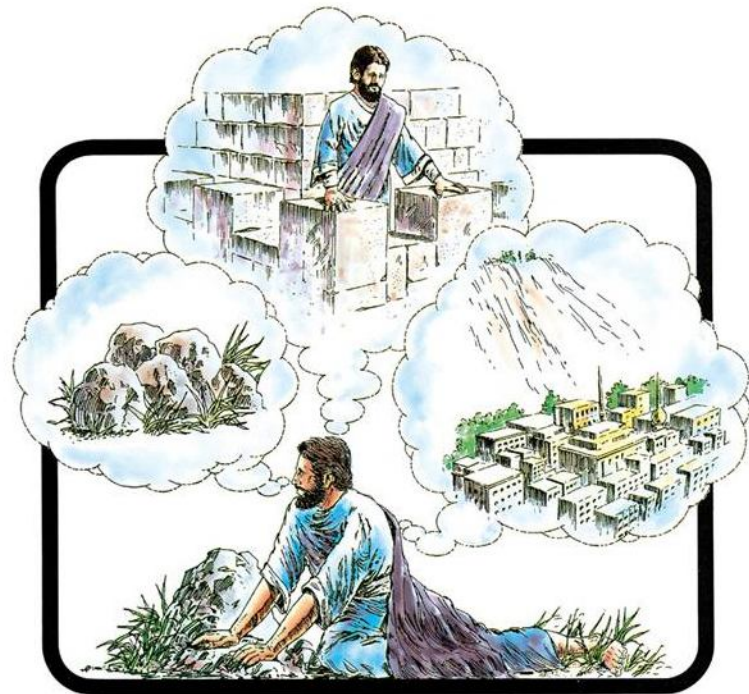
He was fully **God** and fully **man**!

Luke 4:18-19

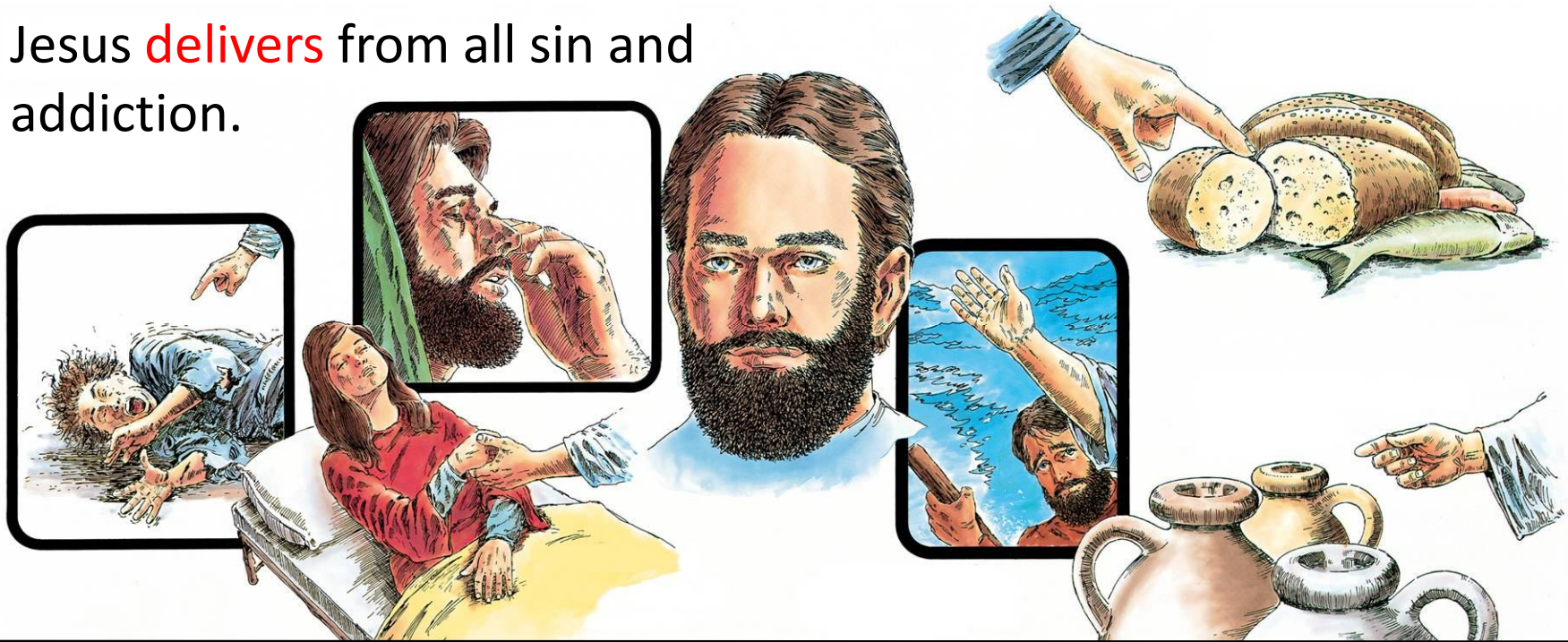
Jesus gives **hope** to the poor.

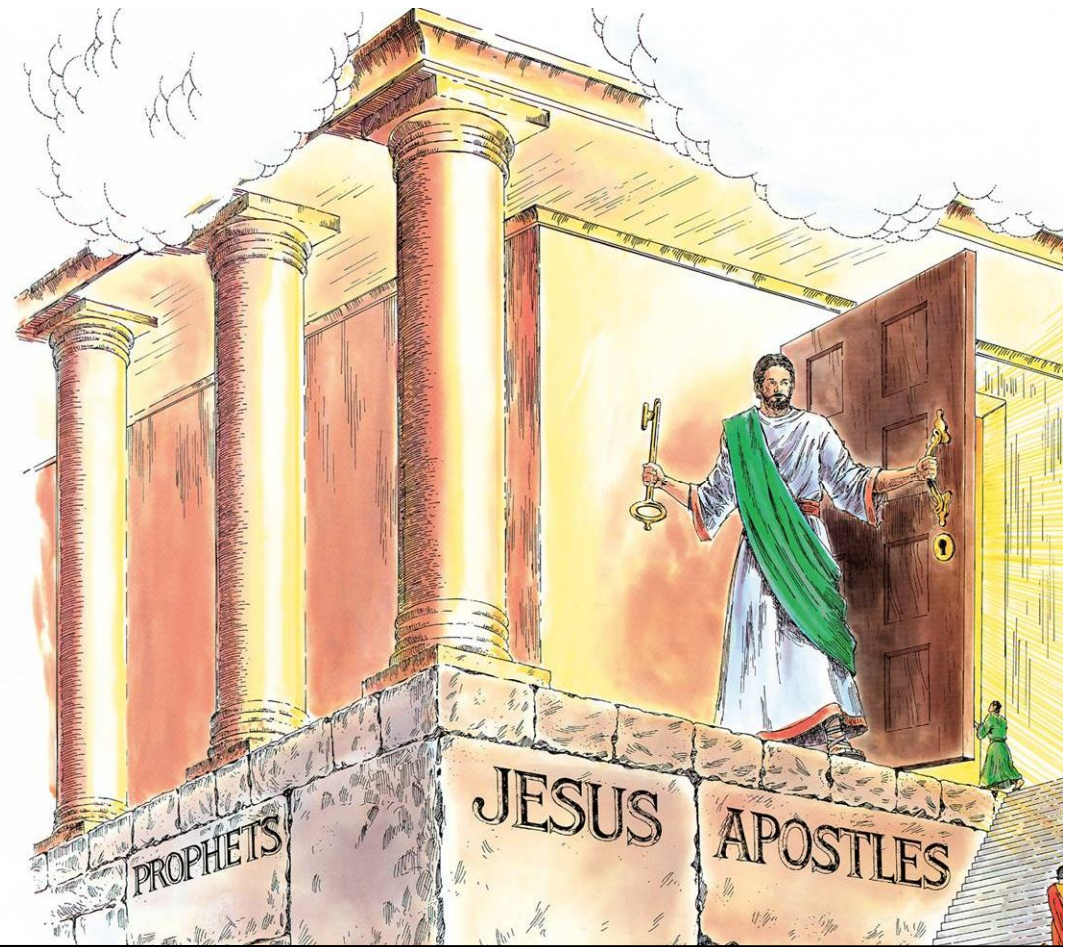
The Gospel *of Jesus Christ*

...His Process



Matthew 27:26, 35-36,50, 58-60, 28:2, 5-6

For you and me, Jesus **died** and was **buried**, but He **rose** again!

Isaiah 53:1-5

Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the Lord revealed?

2 For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him.

3 He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

4 Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

5 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.



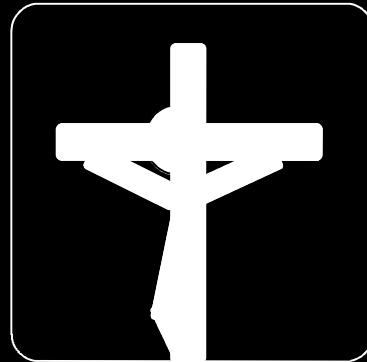
Hebrews 11:6
